What is Pathways?

Pathways is the general education curriculum at Virginia Tech. As a central component of the undergraduate experience, the Pathways

curriculum will allow you to examine the world from multiple perspectives and integrate your knowledge across various disciplines. Along with the coursework required for your major, you will complete credits from nine Pathways concepts (seven core concepts and two integrative concepts).

Core Concepts

You will complete a total of 45 credits across seven Pathways core concepts. The number of credits required per concept is listed below.

- 1 Discourse
 9 credits
 6 Foundational (1f) +
 3 Advanced (1a)
- 2 Critical Thinking in the Humanities 6 credits
- **3** Reasoning in the Social Sciences 6 credits
- Reasoning in the Natural Sciences

5 Quantitative and Computational Thinking

9 credits 6 Foundational (5f) + 3 Advanced (5a) **6** Critique and Practice in Design and the Arts

6 credits 3 Design (6d) + 3 Arts (6a) 7 Critical Analysis of Identity and Equity in the United States

3 credits



APCE Minor Requirements

The Appalachian Cultures and Environments minor includes a required 3-credit introductory course, 12 credits of electives (four courses from five areas), and a 3-hour required capstone course, for a total of 18 credit hours. Together, these required and elective courses offer numerous possible avenues for completing Pathways concepts 1a, 2, 3, 4, 6a, and 7, as illustrated in the diagram to the left.

PSSJ Minor Requirements

The Peace Studies and Social Justice minor includes 3-credit hour required introductory course, 12 credit hours of elective courses from across 4 categories, and a 3-credit hour required integrative capstone course, for a total of 18 credit hours. Together, these required and elective courses numerous possible avenues completing Pathways concepts 1a, 2, 3, 4, and 7, as illustrated in the diagram to the left.
