
PATHWAYS MINORS DISABILITY STUDIES

Requirements

The 21-credit minor in Disability Studies requires five courses from different departments in the College of Liberal Arts and Human Sciences and two 3-credit elective courses.



Required courses

HD 1134: Introduction to Disabilities Studies HD 1004: Human Development I - Childhood and Adolescence STS 3284: Technology & Disability RED 4664: Universal Design --OR-- MUS 2134: Disability Culture & the Arts HD 4714: Senior Capstone Seminar

Elective courses

Students select the remaining six credit hours from a list of four options, including HD 3114: Issues in Aging; HD/EDCI 3144: Education of Exceptional Learners; PSYC 3034: Psychological Disorders of Children; and STS 3314: Medical Dilemmas & Human Experience.
